## 30-Day Rolling Period

### Reason for a 30-Day Rolling Period

Medical Marijuana cardholders can purchase up to 5 ounces of usable marijuana (8 ounces with an approved physician's petition increase) in a rolling 30-day period. The rolling 30-day period tracks purchases that are similar to normal purchasing habits. This process allows for purchases to be added and removed over the course of 30 days, and not based on each calendar month.

#### Tracking Purchases

Cardholders may request a dispensary employee to provide them with their remaining monthly amounts prior to purchasing marijuana or marijuana products. The seed-to-sale tracking system used by marijuana businesses to track sales, also tracks the rolling 30-day sales for a medical cardholder. Additionally, a cardholder can keep track of their purchases by tracking how much they purchase and when they made their purchases. This way they will know when their limits would drop off and become available again.

#### Allowable Amounts

Administrative Rule of Montana 42.39.118(2) establishes allowable amounts of marijuana and marijuana products:

- 1 ounce of marijuana flower
- 800 mg of THC in marijuana products including edibles
- 8 grams or 8 ml of marijuana concentrate

#### Over Sales

A cardholder may call the Cannabis Control Division to inquire about their 30-day rolling purchases. It is a violation for a dispensary employee to sale over personal possession limits, and daily/monthly card limits. However, mistakes happen and an over sale on a card can happen. If there was a sale that was entered incorrectly the department can provide the receipt number, time of the purchase, and where it was purchased from. The cardholder may contact the dispensary to correct the sale and see what their purchasing limit is after correction.

#### Examples

- One pack of edibles with 100 milligrams of THC is equal to 1/8th ounce of usable marijuana.
- One vape cartridge with 1 gram of concentrate is equal to 1/8th ounce of usable marijuana.

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
